





A. What is RFID?

Simply: A barcode that talks

	Old 1.0 Inventory Barcodes	New 2.0 RFID Inventory
Tagging Product	Barcodes on every item	Same + RFID
Collecting Data	Barcode Scanner	Same + RFID Readers + Video Cameras + 100% Automated + 100 items per second
Managing Data	Enter Information in to Database	Same + Media Processor + 24x7 Data Collection
Output	Report Losses	Same + Determine Cause + Respond Now

Label Tag

Garment Tag

- 'Label tag' UHF passive Gen2 900Mhz
 - Read Range: From 1' to 40' the GO TO Tag!
 - from \$0.15 to \$0.50, depending on material
 - Works on many laptops, at reduced range
 - Best prices. Gen 2 UHF 900Mhz.
 - Works on many materials
 - Brands? Many.
- Metal Mount Hard Tag UHF Passive Gen2 900Mhz
 - Read Range: From 1' to 40'
 - from \$2.00 to \$10.00
 - Work on most any surface with consistent range
 - Brands? Few.


• Active Tags? HF / LF? Long Range? GPS/Satelite/Cellular?

- Avoid. There are no standards. Locked into a single-tag vendor.
- These tags will cost \$15-\$500 and will not improve with open market technology improvements. You can't re-use / share your investment.













A. The Workhorse RFID Tag

Label tags are low-cost and powerful.

• What to consider:

- Range? 1' to 40' -- 4"x1" Tags currently read about 40'
- Smaller Size? 1"x1" up to ...
- Label Material? Synthetic or Paper?
 - Synthetic for long print quality life
 - Longest Life: Polyester (10 years)
 - Next Choice: Polypropylene (2 years)
 - Paper for low cost
 - Short life (< 1 year)
- How will I program them? (Get a printer!)
 - Will it work with my RFID printer?
- UHF Class 1 Generation 2 World Standard (Wal Mart, DoD)
- Preprogrammed?

• When to use?

- Whenever you can. Can metal mount with 3/8" foam spacer.
- Will usually work on laptops and most fixed assets. Can be embedded in pallets and other manufactured goods.
- Try it!





A. And then what?

• Antennas at choke points


Place antennas throughout the facility to monitor product movement and update locations.

• Use handheld Readers

Quickly take inventory of RFID tagged items – 100 assets per second

• Integrate with Video

RFID can index a video event and show you what moved where, when.


